Ba cheart na torthaí a chumadh i gcomhthéacs níos leithne i gcónaí. The results of standardised tests administered in 1st-5th classes will be sent in the post to parents before the end of this week. Please contact the class teacher by email if you don't receive same.

It is important to remember that standardised tests such as these form only one part of the 'jigsaw of information' about your child's overall progress. Results should always be framed in a broader context. The school gleans much important information from a variety of valuable sources e.g. routine observation, class/individual tasks, class participation, various assignments/homework, teacher-designed tasks and tests, other tests/reports/feedback. All of this information helps us to plan and work around optimising your child's learning. In the usual way, your child's teacher will be in touch before the summer holidays should a need for further monitoring or support be identified.

We are happy that most parents signed the agreement that children would not have a smart phone, or be granted access to social media or group chats during their time at primary school.

During the year there were presentations for children and parents from second to sixth classes from Zeeko, and Barnardos, and An Garda Síochána and we finish the year's work **tonight at 7:30pm with an Online Safety Information Night with guest speakers from Cybersafe Kids, An Garda Síochána, former GMA student and GMA parent.** We hope a significant number of parents will attend.

With summer around the corner, please see some useful tips below to help parents keep their children safe online:

Internet Safety

We know almost all children will eventually get a mobile phone, (hopefully not until after they have left primary school), and with a phone or other device comes an increased risk of cyberbullying, unprotected use of social media, access to unsuitable content, decreased attention span etc.

Here are some tips to help protect your children and limit some of the above:

- 1) Agree upfront the rules of having a device and that you as their parent ultimately have their password and access to their device, or can confiscate it.
- 2) Set boundaries and limits on screen time - eg, agree what apps they can have access to, set a fixed number of hours screen time per day, have a switch off time each evening an hour or more before bed. Don't allow access to phones in the bedroom overnight. Agree and explain why the boundaries are important in advance with your child.
- 3) Use Parental controls - to set limits as well as control and monitor what apps and websites your children are accessing via their tablet or smartphone - eg Google Family Link is free, many other paid for options are also available.
- 4) Check privacy settings on all their apps are set to private. Turn off Geo-location settings. Public settings mean anyone can know their location and contact and try to befriend them online.
- 5) Teach your child phone and online security:
 - set passwords on their phone, don't share them with friends.
 - turn on "find my phone" setting or similar in case they lose it
 - Discuss and define "Friends" with your child (are they friends In Real Life?), don't accept as a friend anyone they don't know - this friend list determines who has access to everything your child shares.
 - Teach them how to behave online, respect others and avoid drama. Don't overshare online (once a photo or video is out there it can't be taken back), be careful what they write online - the impact of their words and cyberbullying.
